

Volunteer program sets all-time records in 2010

The Ohio State Parks volunteer program set all-time records for the number of volunteers and the hours that they worked in 2010. There were more than 7,600 volunteers who worked over 390,000 hours during the year.

These numbers are a notable increase over 2009 when there were 7,000 volunteers who worked some 350,000 hours. The numbers reflect the increasing importance of volunteers who provide important services such as special events, trail maintenance, nature center program assistance, clean-ups and beautification, etc. in our parks.
